

# Newly Admitted Students: Activate your UTORid

## English transcript

Congratulations on your acceptance to U of T!

To get access to all your online resources and services, you'll need to activate your student credentials as soon as possible.

You can get started as early as the beginning of April for summer classes or the beginning of May for fall.

Your UTORid is your digital credential, used to access University of Toronto systems and resources, including your U of T email address, webinars and lecture recordings for some courses, online library resources and Campus WiFi.

Your TCard is your physical student ID. You'll use it to gain access to places on campus like libraries and athletic facilities, and load funds on it for food, printing and more.

Getting your UTORid and TCard is easy.

Go to [tcard.utoronto.ca](http://tcard.utoronto.ca) and click on Get your UTORid and TCard and scroll down to the step-by-step instructions.

Step 1: Confirm what documentation you need to submit by clicking on the Documentation Tool.

You can also access the tool directly at [uoft.me/tcarddocs](http://uoft.me/tcarddocs).

Select the role of "Undergraduate or graduate student" from the dropdown menu and "First UTORid/TCard."

The tool will ask you a series of questions and let you know what documentation you need to submit based on your answers.

Step 2: Log in and upload your photo and documentation.

Use your JOINid to log in using the link in Step 2.

You can find your JOINid on your offer of acceptance along with your student number.

Step 3: Check your email for approval of your submission, which will be sent to the email listed in your record in ACORN within 1-3 business days.

Shortly after you receive your approval email, you will receive a second email with a Secret Activation Key (SAK) and instructions on how to use it to activate your UTORid.

Step 4: If you're on campus, book an appointment to pick up your TCard.



Visit the Career and Co-Curricular Learning Network or CLNx, at [clnx.utoronto.ca](http://clnx.utoronto.ca) to book an in-person appointment to your campus. You will need to bring your documentation with you to get your card.

Don't wait until the last minute. Skip the start-of-term rush and get access to all of your U of T resources today.
